I am an officer, director, agent, employee, or the owner of a substantial interest¹ in a business entity which is subject to regulation by Midvale City and the value of my interest exceeds \$5,000. I understand that under the disclosure below I must disclose the position I hold and the nature and value of my interest when I am first elected, appointed, or employed by the City and again at any time thereafter if my position in the business entity has changed significantly or if the value of my interest has increased significantly since my most recent disclosure.
